Building Project Up-dates:

Light fixture replacement is almost complete. This project was done with the support of the Energy Trust of Oregon. The new fixtures will allow for better lighting and greatly reduce our electric bill.

We hope to replace four of the 20 year old roof top units this year. Two HVAC units will be installed by crane within the next week. Two more units will be installed early spring.

In October, the Snapdragon carpet will be replaced with an easy to clean Marmoleum floor.

Our carpets will be receiving a good post-summer cleaning in the upcoming week!
